

MINUTES OF A CLOSED EXECUTIVE SESSION  
OF THE HOUSING AUTHORITY  
OF THE CITY OF MILLVILLE  
January 28, 2014

A closed Executive Session of the Housing Authority of the City of Millville was held on Tuesday, January 28, 2014 at 2045 Wheaton Avenue, Cedarview Court Community Room, Millville, New Jersey. The meeting convened at 5:49 p.m. Attending the meeting were: Paul Dice, Allison Corson, Mitch Moore, Heather Santoro, Betsy Loyle, Solicitor Robinson, Commissioner Ring, Commissioner Miller, Commissioner Tomlin and Commissioner Parent.

Secretary Dice advised the Millville Housing Authority and Salem Housing Authority are being sued by a Salem Housing Authority employee. She is claiming she is working in a hostile work environment. This employee has a sister who is a lawyer practicing in Vineland. This lawyer is representing her. Paul Dice has been named in the suit, as well as Betsy Loyle and Kari Elmer. This employee is unable to work with her supervisor and knows that we have not been happy with her work performance.

Arnold Robinson advised he has been in contact with Bob Conner regarding our employment practice liability insurance and he believes we are adequately covered.

The Millville Board members indicated they would like to review the tort notice.

In other legal matters, Arnold Robinson advised he has filed for arbitration regarding the Bridgeton Villas account. Chairman Tomlin asked that the board be kept informed.
