

MINUTES OF A CLOSED EXECUTIVE SESSION
OF THE HOUSING AUTHORITY
OF THE CITY OF MILLVILLE
May 25, 2010

A closed Executive Session of the Housing Authority of the City of Millville was held on Tuesday, May 25, 2010 at Maurice View Plaza Community Room, 1 E. Vine Street, Millville, New Jersey. The meeting convened at 6:15 p.m.

Dice advised the Board that some residents of JCP had secured legal representation in opposition to the proposed consolidation of the ALP. Dice shared the letter of representation he received from Legal Services of NJ. He advised the Board that he and Attorney Arnold Robinson will be meeting with Legal Services to discuss the case.

Secretary Paul Dice told the board members he would like to approach the Millville Police Department regarding contracting for services at \$25,000 per year. The police department is facing lay-offs and may consider this contract if it may help save jobs. The Housing Authority is in need of a police presence at our high- rise buildings. Solicitor Robinson explained a Memorandum of Understanding should be created saying we will pay the police department monthly as long as we are getting the services we contracted for. Chairman Miller requested a monthly report should be presented to the board if we enter into this understanding.

There being no further discussion or business; Chairman Miller asked for a motion to adjourn the Closed Executive Session and return to the open session of the MHA. Commissioner Kelley made the motion to adjourn at 6:35 p.m. Commissioner Parent seconded. All present were in favor.
